Building Accessibility

The AAW Gallery of Wood Art is located in Landmark Center. Both the gallery and building are wheelchair and disabled accessible.

Parking

Parking is free for a maximum of four hours at all 1, 2, and 4-hour meters if you display a valid disabled parking tag/sticker.

Entrance

The wheelchair entrance is located on the Market Street side of the building. The accessibility elevator goes up to the first floor, or four low steps to climb.

The main elevators are directly across the hallway as you exit the accessibility elevator.

Important: Market Street is occasionally closed for special events, so please call ahead. If you have any questions or concerns, contact Landmark Center at 651-292-3233.

Wheelchair Availability

A wheelchair may be reserved in advance by contacting Landmark Center at 651-292-3233.

Service Animals

Service animals are welcome in the building and in the AAW Gallery of Wood Art.

Restrooms

Wheelchair accessible restrooms are located on the second floor, to the left as you exit the elevator.

Visiting the Gallery

We are on the second floor. Turn right as you exit the main elevators. The AAW Gallery of Wood Art will be the first door on the left.

Large Print

Large print copies of our schedule and this brochure are available on request. We are happy to provide assistance with reading labels and interpretive signs if desired. Large print exhibit labels and texts are available for selected exhibitions.

Touch Tours

Blind or low-vision visitors may request an individually guided 'touch tour' of the exhibits. Your guide will indicate which pieces and equipment may be touched. Visitors may be asked to wear cotton gloves. (Gloves will be provided by your guide.)

Display Height

If artwork on display is too high for you to see, let the staff know. In most cases we can move the piece so that you can view it more easily.

Wheelchair accessibility

The gallery exhibits are all on one level, and exhibit aisles are 42" wide to accommodate standard wheelchairs.

ASL Interpreters

We do not provide interpreters at this time.

Closed Captioning

We play videos of woodturning demonstrations in the gallery. Some of our videos are not subtitled. If a subtitled video is not playing, please let us know and we will change videos.
